

Apache Springs Ranch Hosts Carlos Tabernaberry

Apache Springs Ranch is a 160-acre private ranch located inside Arizona's 500,000-acre Coronado National Forest, bordering the Mount Wrightson Wilderness Area. The ranch sits at an elevation of one mile in the cool Santa Rita Mountains, less than an hour south of Tucson. Immerse yourself in the high-desert wilderness while also enjoying the true comfort of traditional Southern Arizona accommodations.

Australia's horse gentler, trainer, and author of *Through the Eyes of the Horse*, is known worldwide for the remarkable partnerships he guides people to create with their horses. Carlos's passion with horses began as a young boy in Argentina where he made a life-time promise to share the knowledge from the horse's perspective. When his family moved to Australia, his unique philosophy grew with an understanding of how to strengthen the bond between horses and humans.

Carlos teaches the art of listening by engaging the horse through a calm, centered posture; aligning rhythm; and softness on the ground and in the saddle. He instructs riders and horses from the varied disciplines of dressage, eventing, western, endurance, and trail riding.

"How your horse sees you on the ground will determine how he sees you on his back, so it starts with simple, powerful groundwork that serves a purpose under saddle. It also helps ensure your horse is calm and able to learn."

The historic Apache Springs Ranch has invited Carlos to offer his experience, teachings, and horse wisdom for three weekend clinics: March 4-6, March 11-13, and March 18-20, 2016.

You will experience how to:

- become a confident, consistent, kind leader and rider
- earn your horse's trust and respect, beginning on the ground
- recognize the willingness of your horse
- understand the myths about riding & the biomechanics of your horse
- develop responsiveness without the use of a bit
- improve suppleness and balance

Each 3-day clinic is limited to 12 riders with open attendance to anyone who wishes to observe.

Apache Springs Ranch has a variety of overnight accommodations available, including: luxurious guest rooms in the completely restored ranch house, casitas, and private rooms with shared baths. We also have limited space for horse trailers with living quarters. These are reserved for clinic attendees on a first-come, first-served basis.

Room rates range from \$160 to \$225 per night. A three-meal plan is available for \$40 per day for participants and \$65 per day for auditors. Attendees staying in one of our rooms for 3+ nights will receive a \$100 credit towards a meal plan.
